During the ceremony, teachers and traffic safety educators encouraged children to think of their helmets as their "new friends," companions that will play an important part in their daily lives. By creating a bond between the child and their helmet and engaging the students in interactive activities like peer musical performances, *Helmets for Kids* aims to make traffic safety fun and engaging for Vietnam's youth.
